Rome, 29 June 2004 Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul

Dearest Sisters,

On the solemnity of the Holy Apostles Peter and Paul, in fulfillment of what article 131 of our Rule of Life prescribes, with the consent of my Council, I am happy to announce to you all the *indiction of the 7*th *General Chapter* which will be celebrated in the month of July 2005.

* Duties of the Chapter

It will be an ordinary Chapter during which we will carry out the duties stated in article 130 of our Rule of Life, according to the Itinerary of preparation sent to you last December and having as its theme: "Leading to the springs of life: to live and to give Jesus Good Shepherd to humanity of today".

* Venue and date

The venue will be "Divine Master" House, in Ariccia (Rome).

On 29 June 2005, Solemnity of the Apostles Peter and Paul, with the Chapter delegates and all the Sisters who are able to be present, we will gather around the Urn of our Father Founder, in the inferior Crypt of the Basilica "Regina Apostolorum", for the Family Eucharistic celebration, which will mark the opening of the 7th General Chapter.

The days from 30 June to 3 July will be days of spirituality.

The 7th General Chapter will officially begin on 4 July and its conclusion is foreseen on 20 July.

* Participants

Those who take part by right:

The superior general, the general councillors, the bursar general, the secretary general, the provincial superiors, the superior general of the immediately preceding term of office.

Those who take part by election:

The provincial delegates elected according to the norm in article 118.3.

The delegates of the different Delegations elected according to the norm in article 103.1

With regards to Colombia-Venezuela-Mexico Delegation, considering the complexity of its reality, as in the previous Chapter, we consider it appropriate that it be represented by two delegates, with authorization from the Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life.
